## YMCA Donations

Onwards and Uplands Community group raised the issue of unnecessary wastage of recyclable goods at the end of the academic year which has previously been going to landfill. The result has been a partnership project between this group, the University, the YMCA, Swansea Council Waste and Parks teams, Uplands Market and local Councillors and has resulted in pop up collection points in Brynmill and Victoria Parks and at Uplands Market.
